

Regional Districts and the Community Charter

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The *Community Charter* provides the statutory framework for all municipalities in BC, except the City of Vancouver, and sets out municipalities' core areas of authority. In order for certain provisions of the *Community Charter* to apply equally to regional districts, cross references were added to the *Local Government Act*. This guide provides a convenient reference showing which provisions in the *Community Charter* also apply to regional districts.

The *Community Charter* is separated into 9 Parts, which are made up of Divisions that are divided into sections. In the first column of this guide, Parts, Divisions and sections of the *Community Charter* that apply to regional districts are highlighted and links are provided. The corresponding sections in the *Local Government Act* appear in the second column, under the heading "LGA".



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
