DIRECTION TO THE REGISTRY

Extension of Grace Period to October 31, 2012 for Registry Acceptance of Repealed Forms 8, 35, 79, F37, F38, F51, F52, F53 and F85

By Order in Council 192, approved and ordered on March 29, 2012, the following Supreme Court Civil and Family Forms were repealed and new Forms were substituted effective April 25, 2012:

- Form 8 - Default Judgment
- Form 35 - Order Made After Application
- Form 79 - Order For Indigent Status
- Form F37 - Child Support Affidavit
- Form F38 - Affidavit - Desk Order Divorce
- Form 51 - Order Made After Application
- Form F52 - Final Order
- Form F54 - Restraining Order
- Form F85 - Order for Indigent Status

I previously directed that until July 31, 2012, Registry staff should continue to accept the former Forms.

I am now directing a further extension of this 'grace period' to October 31, 2012.
