### **SCHEDULE**

- 1 Section 16 of the Forest Planning and Practices Regulation, B.C. Reg. 14/2004 is amended by adding the following:
  - (5) A holder of a major licence that is a forestry licence to cut entered into under section 24.8 of the *Forest Act* or converted into a forestry licence to cut under section 24.9 of the *Forest Act* is exempt from this section.
- 2 Sections 39 (1) and (2) and 55 (1) are amended by adding "a road," before "a temporary access structure".
- 3 The following section is added:

## Exemption respecting free growing stand for certain forestry licences to cut

- 45.1 A holder of a major licence that is a forestry licence to cut entered into under section 24.8 of the *Forest Act* or converted into a forestry licence to cut under section 24.9 of the *Forest Act* is exempt from section 29 (1) of the *Forest and Range Practices Act*.
- 4 Section 46 (1) (a) is repealed and the following substituted:
  - (a) a cutblock is harvested under a forestry licence to cut that
    - (i) is not a major licence or a minor tenure, or
    - (ii) is a major licence and was entered into under section 24.8 of the *Forest Act* or converted into a forestry licence to cut under section 24.9 of the *Forest Act*, and.
- 5 Section 75 is amended by striking out everything before paragraph (a) and substituting the following: "A person who maintains a road must do one or more of the following if a structural defect or deficiency occurs on a bridge that is part of that road:".
- 6 Section 85 (1) is amended by striking out "a permanent access structure" and substituting "not a temporary access structure".
- 7 Section 86 is amended
  - (a) in subsection (3) (a) by adding "or to which section 44 (4) of this regulation applies" after "of the Act applies", and
  - (b) by repealing subsection (4) (a) and substituting the following:
    - (a) the following information about road construction during the reporting period, by the timber sales manager, a holder of a timber sale licence or a holder of a road permit that was granted under the *Forest Act* by the timber sales manager:
      - (i) the location of the road;

- (ii) the location, type and overall length of any bridges;
- (iii) the location and the diameter or span of any major culverts and of any fish-stream culverts;
- (iv) the stream crossing identifiers for bridges and culverts referred to in subparagraphs (ii) and (iii);
- (v) the location of engineered structures other than bridges, culverts or fords;
- (vi) the location of road sections containing stumps, roots and embedded logs left or placed
  - (A) under the road fill within the road prism width, if the road is located on landslide prone terrain, or
  - (B) under the travelled portion of the road fill for other road locations, and.
- 8 Sections 87 (1) and (2) and 88 (1) and (2) are amended by adding "or to which section 44 (4) of this regulation applies" after "of the Act applies."
- 9 Section 93 is repealed.
- 10 The Part 8 heading is repealed and the following substituted:

## **PART 8 - OFFENCES**

- 11 Division 1 of Part 8 is repealed.
- 12 The heading for Division 2 of Part 8 is repealed.
- 13 Sections 107.1 and 107.2 are repealed.
- 14 The following section is added:

#### Application of Code to certain forest development plans

107.3 The Code and the Code regulations apply to forest development plans described in section 187 of the Act.
