


On the recommendation of the Attorney General, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that, effective May 31, 2005, the Violation Ticket Administration and Fines Regulation, B.C. Reg. 89/97, is amended in Schedule 2 by repealing the heading "Sewage Disposal Regulation, B.C. Reg. 411/85", and the items under it and substituting the following:

Sewerage System Regulation, B.C. Reg. xxx/2004

section 12 (a)	Knowingly make a false or misleading statement	\$500	\$75	\$575
section 12 (b)	Construct a sewerage system without proper qualifications	\$600	\$90	\$690
section 12 (c)	Construct a holding tank or sewerage system in a manner that causes a health hazard	\$500	\$75	\$575
section 12 (c)	Maintain a holding tank or sewerage system in a manner that contributes to a health hazard	\$300	\$45	\$345
section 12 (d)	Fail to comply with a requirement or order	\$500	\$75	\$575
section 12 (e)	Operate a holding tank or sewerage system without a permit or letter of certification	\$600	\$90	\$690
