

- (a) sections 14 (b) and (c) and 15 of the *Water, Land and Air Protection Statutes Amendment Act, 2003*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 90, are brought into force,
- (b) the *Park and Recreation Area Regulation*, B.C. Reg. 180/90, is amended according to the attached Appendix A, and
- (c) the *Conservation Officer Service Authority Regulation*, B.C. Reg. 318/2004, is amended according to the attached Appendix B.

APPENDIX A

- 1 *Section 1 of the Park and Recreation Area Regulation, B.C. Reg. 180/90, is amended*
 - (a) *by repealing the definitions of “minister”, “natural resources”, “park officer”, “park ranger”, “park use permit”, “recreation area” and “resource use permit”, and*
 - (b) *by repealing the definition of “park” and substituting the following:*

“park” includes any land, trail, path or waterway comprised in an order under section 6 (1) (a) to (g) of the Act; .
- 2 *Section 6 is repealed.*
- 3 *The following Division is added:*

Division 9 – Park Rangers

Park ranger responsibilities

- 56 The following enactments are prescribed for purposes of section 4 (3) (b) of the Act:
- (a) regulations under the *Ecological Reserve Act*;
 - (b) sections 12 and 13 of the *Environmental Management Act*;
 - (c) section 9 of the *Firearm Act*;
 - (d) *Liquor Control and Licensing Act*;
 - (e) *Motor Vehicle Act* and regulations under that Act;
 - (f) *Motor Vehicle (All Terrain) Act* and regulations under that Act;
 - (g) sections 4, 5 and 8 of the *Trespass Act*.

APPENDIX B

- 1 *The table of the Conservation Officer Service Authority Regulation, B.C. Reg. 318/2004, is amended in column 2 by striking out “Park and Recreation Area Regulation, B.C. Reg. 180/90” and substituting “Park Act”.*
