On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the Motor Fuel Tax Regulation, B.C. Reg. 414/85, is amended as follows:

- 1 Section 7 is amended
  - (a) in paragraph (b) by striking out "person, or" and substituting "person,",
  - (b) in paragraph (c) by adding ", or" at the end, and
  - (c) by adding the following paragraph:
    - (d) by using a dye injector that is mounted on a truck.
- 2 Section 9 is amended by striking out the portion of section 9 preceding paragraph (a) and substituting the following:
  - On or before the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the month in which an authorized person uses dye to colour fuel, as permitted in section 7, the authorized person must deliver to the director, in the form specified by the director, a statement of the quantity of dye and premixed dye solution.
- 3 Section 10 is amended by adding "or (d)" after "section 7 (c)"
