

SCHEDULE

1 Schedule 2 of the Violation Ticket Administration and Fines Regulation, B.C. Reg. 89/97, is amended under the heading “Environmental Management Act”

(a) in Column 2 opposite “section 6 (2)”, by striking out “Introduce business waste” and substituting the following:

Introduce waste from a prescribed industry, trade or business ,

(b) in Column 2 opposite “section 6 (3)”, by striking out “Introduce waste of prescribed activity” and substituting the following:

Introduce waste by prescribed activity or operation , *and*

(c) by adding the following entry under the heading “Waste Discharge Regulation, B.C. Reg. 320/2004:

Provision	Contravention	Fine	Victim Surcharge Levy	Ticketed Amount
section 6 (1)	Fail to comply with a code of practice other than a waste introduction requirement	\$500	\$75	\$575
