**1 Rule 13 of the Supreme Court Rules, B.C. Reg. 221/90, is amended**


**(a) by repealing subrule (1) and substituting the following:**


**Service outside British Columbia without leave**

(1) Service of an originating process or other document on a person outside British Columbia may be effected without leave in any of the circumstances enumerated in section 10 of the *Court Jurisdiction and Proceedings Transfer Act*, and

**(b) in subrule (2) by striking out "grounds referred to in subrule (1)" and substituting "circumstances enumerated in section 10 of the *Court Jurisdiction and Proceedings Transfer Act*".**

**2 Form 6 is amended by striking out "[State ground and provision in Rule 13 (1) upon which the plaintiff relies]" and substituting "[State the circumstances, enumerated in section 10 of the *Court Jurisdiction and Proceedings Transfer Act*, on which the plaintiff relies]".**
