

ORDER OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

Order in Council No. 340 , Approved and Ordered MAY 11 2006

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that, effective July 1, 2006, the Consumer Contracts Regulation, B.C. Reg. 272/2004, is amended as follows:

1 *The following section is added:*


Continuing services contract – exemption from application of the Act

2.1 Section 24 (3) and (6) of the Act does not apply to a continuing services contract that provides the consumer with the right to cancel the contract

- (a) at any time or at any time after an initial term of 2 years or less for the contract,
- (b) on giving 30 days written notice of the cancellation to the supplier,
- (c) without giving reasons for the cancellation, and
- (d) without cost to the consumer.

2 *Section 7 (1) (b) is repealed and the following substituted:*

- (b) if the contract is a direct sales contract or time share contract, in the form set out in Schedule A.
