## **APPENDIX**

- 1 Item 2 of the Schedule to the Motor Vehicle Fees Regulation, B.C. Reg. 334/91, is amended in Column 1 by repealing paragraphs (e) (i) (A) and (B) and substituting the following:
  - (A) a foreign state that has an office located in British Columbia.
  - (B) a consular post, as defined in the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations, set out in Schedule II of the *Foreign Missions and International Organizations Act* (Canada), that has an office located in British Columbia,
  - (C) an international organization that has been provided with privileges and immunities under section 5 of the Foreign Missions and International Organizations Act (Canada) and has an office located in British Columbia
  - (D) an office of a political subdivision of a foreign state that has been granted privileges and immunities under section 6 of the Foreign Missions and International Organizations Act (Canada) and is located in British Columbia, or
  - (E) a foreign representative or the spouse or a dependent of a foreign representative if
    - (I) the foreign representative, spouse or dependent is resident in British Columbia and is not a Canadian citizen or permanent resident, as defined in the *Immigrant and Refugee Protection Act* (Canada), and
    - (II) in relation to an office referred to in clauses (A) to (D), the foreign representative, spouse or dependent has been granted privileges, immunities or benefits under the *Foreign Missions and International Organizations Act* (Canada) that have not been withdrawn.
- 2 Section 19.14 of the Motor Vehicle Act Regulations, B.C. Reg. 26/58, is amended by adding the following paragraphs:
  - (d) a foreign state;
  - (e) a consular post, as defined in the Vienna Convention on Consular Relations, set out in Schedule II of the *Foreign Missions and International Organizations Act* (Canada);
  - (f) an international organization that has been provided with privileges and immunities under section 5 of the *Foreign Missions and International Organizations Act* (Canada);
  - (g) an office of a political subdivision of a foreign state that has been granted privileges and immunities under section 6 of the *Foreign Missions and International Organizations Act* (Canada) that have not been withdrawn.
