






## SCHEDULE

**1** *Section 4 of the Forest Planning and Practices Regulation, B.C. Reg. 14/2004, is amended by adding the following:*

(2.1) A land surveyor may cut, damage or destroy Crown timber as necessary in the course of carrying out duties as a land surveyor.

**2** *Section 85 (1) is amended*

*(a) in paragraph (a) (i) by striking out “in a cutblock that comprises more than one hectare”, and*

*(b) in paragraph (b) by striking out “that comprises more than one hectare”.*

**3** *Section 86 (1) is amended in the definition of “reporting period” by striking out “subsection (2)” and substituting “subsections (2) to (5)”.*
