



On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the Access to PharmaNet Patient Record Information Regulation, B.C. Reg. 537/2004, is amended as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of the Access to PharmaNet Patient Record Information Regulation is amended by repealing the definition of "hospital" and substituting the following:  
"designated location" means any of the following:
  - (a) a hospital, as defined in section 1 of the Hospital Act, other than a hospital or that part of a hospital that is a designated facility referred to in paragraph (c);
  - (b) a medical practice;
  - (c) a designated facility, as defined in the Mental Health Act; .
  
- 2 Sections 2 (c) (ii) and 3 (b) are amended by striking out "a hospital emergency department or a medical practice" and substituting "a designated location".
