And further take notice that if within 14 days after receipt by you of this notice, which notice you are deemed to have received on the eighth day after mailing of the notice by the Corporation, you do not reply to the Corporation, either denying liability for the incident described above or making arrangements satisfactory to the Corporation for the disposition or settlement of the demand contained in or presented by the Application, the Corporation may settle with or consent to judgment in favour of any applicant or the Corporation may take such other action as is authorized by section 20 of the *Insurance (Motor Vehicle) Act*, including paying all or part of a settlement or judgment, and upon further notice to you, the Corporation may demand reimbursement from you of the payments with interest thereon or the Corporation may take such other action as may be necessary to recover the amounts of the payments.
