

ORDER OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

Order in Council No. 309 , Approved and Ordered MAY 25 2007

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that, effective June 1, 2007, section 43 of the Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation, B.C. Reg. 244/2002, is amended

(a) by repealing subsections (1), (3), (4), (6) and (8) and substituting the following:

- (1) For the purposes of this regulation and section 13 of the Act, “**training program**” means the training program entitled “Serving It Right: The Responsible Beverage Service Program”, delivered under the auspices of a person or organization approved by the general manager.
- (3) For the purposes of section 13 of the Act, the training program is prescribed.
- (8) Subject to subsection (7) of this section, before allowing a person to manage or serve liquor in a licensed establishment to which section 13 of the Act applies, the licensee must verify that the person has successfully completed the training program. ,

(b) in subsections (7) and (9) by striking out “a training program” and substituting “the training program”, and

(c) in Items 22 and 23 of Schedule 4 by striking out “required”.
