


## SCHEDULE

That the Drug Schedules Regulation be amended by the deletion of:

- 4 Levonorgestrel (when used for emergency contraception)

and by the addition of:

- 2 Levonorgestrel (when sold in concentrations of 0.75mg per oral dosage unit, packaged and labelled for emergency contraception).
