

- 1** *Section 1 of the Motion Picture Regulations, B.C. Reg. 296/2003, are amended by repealing the definition of “salesperson”.*
- 2** *Section 7 is amended by striking out “The fees” and substituting “Subject to any applicable fees set by the administrative authority, the fees”.*
- 3** *Section 8 is amended*
 - (a) in subsection (1) by striking out “The fees” and substituting “Subject to any applicable fees set by the administrative authority, the fees”,*
 - (b) in subsection (2) by striking out “shall accurately complete Form 1 and deliver it to the director” and substituting “must provide the director with the information the director requires”,*
 - (c) in subsection (5) by striking out “facts and information provided in Form 1” and substituting “information provided under section (2)”, and*
 - (d) in subsection (7) by striking out “officer” and substituting “senior officer, as defined in the Business Corporations Act.”.*
- 4** *Section 8.1 is amended*
 - (a) in subsection (1) by striking out “the Consent for Criminal Record Search in Form 3” and substituting “a criminal record check authorization satisfactory to the director”,*
 - (b) in subsection (1) (c) by striking out “officer” and substituting “senior officer, as defined in the Business Corporations Act”,*
 - (c) by repealing paragraph (1) (d), and*
 - (d) in subsection (2) (b) by striking out “Consent for Criminal Record Search” and substituting “criminal record check authorization”.*
- 5** *Section 8.2 is repealed.*
- 6** *Section 12 (5) is amended by striking out “The fee” and substituting “Subject to any applicable fee set by the administrative authority, the fee”.*
- 7** *Forms 1 and 3 are repealed.*
