APPENDIX 1

1 Section 32 of Schedule 5 of the Closed Areas Regulation, B.C. Reg. 76/84, is amended by striking out

“northern boundary of the right of way of the B.C. Hydro powerline; thence westerly along said right of way boundary to the point of intersection with the natural boundary of the Jordan River”

and substituting

“northern boundary of the right of way of the B.C. Hydro powerline; thence westerly along said right of way boundary to the point of intersection with Young Lake Road, then generally North and perpendicular to said right of way for a distance of 800 m, then generally west paralleling said right of way to the point of intersection with the East bank of Tugwell Creek, then generally South following the East bank of Tugwell Creek to the intersection with the North boundary of the right of way of said powerline, then generally westerly along said right of way to the point of intersection with the natural boundary of the Jordan River”.

(b) in section 1 (1) of Schedule 1 by striking out “and except the roads highlighted in green on Map No. 1-1”,

(c) in section 72 of Schedule 1 by striking out “Map No. 1-72/07” and substituting “Map No. 1-72/08”,

(d) in section 73 of Schedule 1 by striking out “Map No. 1-73/07” and substituting “Map No. 1-73/08”,

(e) Map No. 1-72/07 and Map No. 1-73/07 are repealed and the attached Map No. 1-72/08 and Map No. 1-73/08 are substituted,

(f) in section 9 (a) of Schedule 2 by striking out “Kishenina and Akamina Creeks” and substituting “Kishinena and Akamina Creeks upstream from the 97 km marker of the Kishinena Akamina Forest Service Road”,

(g) in section 12 (k) of Schedule 2 by striking out “64 km” and substituting “66.5 km”, and

(h) in section 7 of Schedule 7 by striking out “That portion” in each of paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) and substituting “Effective year round, in that portion”.

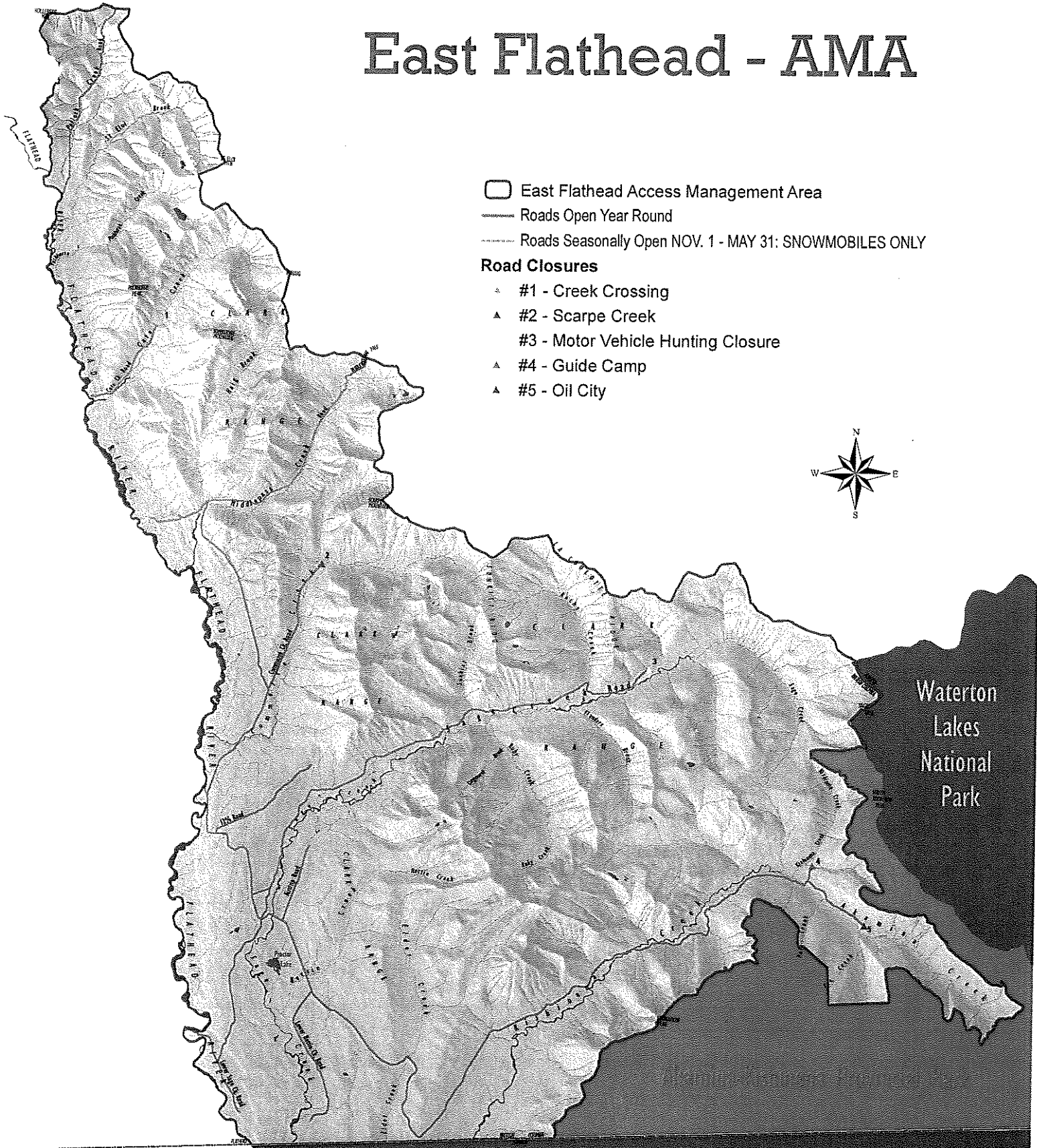

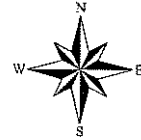

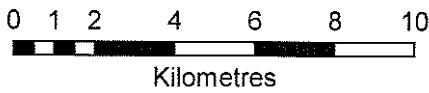

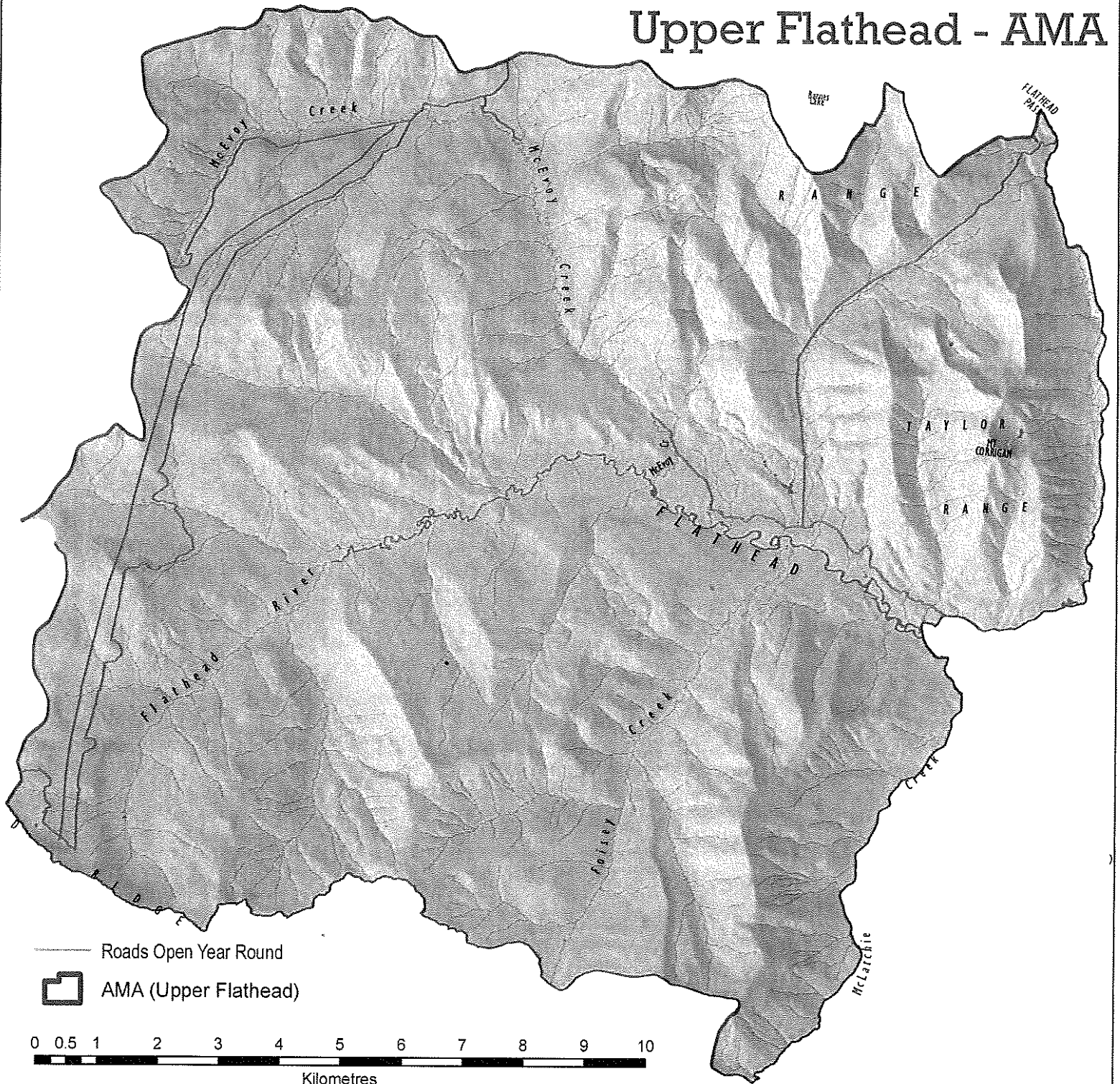
