NURSES (REGISTERED PSYCHIATRIC) REGULATION

Definitions

1 In this regulation:

"Act" means the Health Professions Act;

"psychiatric nursing" means practice as a registrant of the college.

College name

The name "College of Registered Psychiatric Nurses of British Columbia" is the name of the college established under section 15 (1) of the Act for psychiatric nursing.

Reserved titles

- 3 (1) The titles "registered psychiatric nurse" and "licensed graduate psychiatric nurse" are reserved for exclusive use by registrants.
 - (2) This section does not prevent a person from using the title "nurse" in a manner authorized by another regulation under section 12 of the Act.

Scope of practice

4 A registrant may practise psychiatric nursing.

Patient relations program

5 The college is designated for the purposes of section 16 (2) (f) of the Act.
