

SCHEDULE

- 1** *Section 1 (2) of the Film and Television Tax Credit Regulation, B.C. Reg 4/99, is amended in paragraph (b) (i) of the definition of “BC-controlled” by striking out “a BC-based individual, or” and substituting “an individual who, by reason of being an individual described in section 2 (1) (a) of the Act, is subject to tax under section 2 of the Act for the year preceding the year in which principal photography of the eligible production begins, or”.*
- 2** *The following section is added:*

Distant location

- 11** For the purposes of the definition of “distant location” in section 79 (1) of the Act, the area prescribed as a distant location is all of the area of British Columbia that is outside the designated Vancouver area except the following areas:
- (a) the area of the Greater Vancouver Regional District that is outside the designated Vancouver area;
 - (b) the Capital Regional District;
 - (c) the District of Squamish;
 - (d) the Resort Municipality of Whistler;
 - (e) Electoral Area D of the Squamish-Lillooet Regional District;
 - (f) the City of Abbotsford;
 - (g) the City of Chilliwack;
 - (h) the Village of Harrison Hot Springs;
 - (i) the District of Hope;
 - (j) The Corporation of the District of Kent;
 - (k) the District of Mission;
 - (l) Electoral Area H of the Fraser Valley Regional District;
 - (m) the area of the Fraser Valley Regional District bounded on the north by the Fraser River, on the east by the District of Hope, on the south by Highway 1 and on the west by the City of Chilliwack.
