## **SCHEDULE**

- 1 Section 1 of the Free Use Permit Regulation, B.C. Reg. 335/99, is amended by
  - (a) repealing paragraph (c) and substituting the following:
    - (c) is not carried out for profit or for a commercial purpose, including trading and bartering, and, *and*
  - (b) adding the following paragraph:
    - (d) is not carried out for the purpose of constructing a residential dwelling except for a residential dwelling constructed by an aboriginal community with an aboriginal right to timber that includes constructing residential dwellings.
- 2 Section 2 is amended by
  - (a) striking out ", but not exceeding 250 m<sup>3</sup>,", and
  - (b) striking out "a longhouse, community hall, or other similar structure." and substituting the following:
    - (a) a longhouse, community hall or other similar structure, or
    - (b) a residential dwelling constructed by an aboriginal community with an aboriginal right to timber that includes constructing residential dwellings.
