


- (a) the *Partnership Amendment Act*, 2004, S.B.C. 2004, c. 38, is brought into force, and
- (b) the *Partnership Regulation*, B.C. Reg. 524/78, is amended according to the attached Schedule.

## SCHEDULE

**1** *The Partnership Regulation, B.C. Reg. 524/78, is amended in section 3 by adding the following subsection:*

- (3) For the purposes of sections 109 (3), 121 (3) and 123 (2), the prescribed fee is \$10.00 to see the list, plus \$0.50 each page for a copy.

**2** *The following sections are added:*

**Prescribed publication**

- 5** For the purposes of section 98 (1) (b) of the Act, a notice must be published on a website maintained by or on behalf of the government of British Columbia.

**Prescribed address**

- 6** (1) For the purposes of the Act, the prescribed address for a partner in a limited liability partnership is that described under subsection (2) (a) or (b) and specified in the records of the partnership for this purpose.
- (2) To specify the address for a partner for purposes of subsection (1), one but not both of the following paragraphs must be specified:
- (a) the delivery address of the partnership and, if different from that delivery address, the mailing address of that partnership, or
  - (b) the delivery address of the of the office or residence at which the partner can usually be served with records during statutory business hours and, if different from that delivery address, the mailing address of that office or residence.
