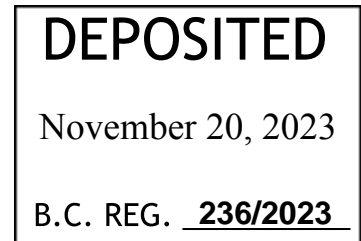

## APPENDIX

### *1 The Schedules to the Drug Schedules Regulation, B.C. Reg. 9/98, are amended*

#### *(a) by adding the following:*

- 1 Azelastine and its salts
- 1 Bepotastine and its salts or derivatives
- 1 Besifloxacin and its salts
- 1 Efinaconazole
- 3 Loratidine and its salts and preparations in products labelled for use in children aged 2 to 11 years, in package sizes containing greater than 140 mg of loratidine
- 1 Ozenoxacin and its salts
- 1 Rupatadine and its salts
- 1 Trifarotene and its salts , *and*

#### *(b) by striking out the following:*

- 3 Loratidine and its salts and preparations in products marketed for pediatric use (under 12 years of age) .
