 - (a) by repealing the definition of "public distributed learning school", and
 - (b) by adding the following definition:
 - "public online learning school" means an online learning school as defined in the *School Act*.
- 2 Section 2 (1) is amended by striking out "distributed learning" wherever it appears and substituting "online learning".
- 3 Section 3 is amended
 - (a) in subsection (1) by striking out "a distributed learning independent school" and substituting "an online learning independent school",
 - (b) in subsection (2) by striking out "distributed learning independent school" and substituting "online learning independent school",
 - (c) in subsections (2) (b) and (5) by striking out "public distributed learning school" and substituting "public online learning school", and
 - (d) in subsections (6) and (7) by striking out "distributed learning" and substituting "online learning".
- 4 Sections 4 and 4.1 are amended by striking out "a distributed learning independent school" wherever it appears and substituting "an online learning independent school".
- 5 Section 6 (3) (b), (4) and (5) is amended by striking out "distributed learning" and substituting "online learning".
