## SCHEDULE

*1 Part 7 of the Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation, B.C. Reg. 241/2016, is amended by adding the following Division:*

### **Division 10 – Provisional Sales and Purchases**

#### **Definitions**

**206.2** In this Division:

**“provisional purchaser”** means a person who holds any of the following:

- (a) a liquor primary licence;
- (b) a liquor primary club licence;
- (c) a food primary licence;
- (d) a catering licence;
- (e) a manufacturer licence endorsed with a lounge endorsement;

**“provisional seller”** means a person who holds any of the following:

- (a) a licensee retail store licence;
- (b) a wine store licence;
- (c) a special wine store licence;
- (d) a rural licensee retail store licence.

#### **Authorized provisional sales and purchases**

- 206.3**
- (1) The licence of a provisional seller authorizes the licensee to sell liquor in unopened containers in the service area under the licence to a provisional purchaser.
  - (2) A provisional seller must not sell liquor under this section unless the provisional seller has first received from the provisional purchaser
    - (a) the provisional purchaser’s licence number, and
    - (b) any additional information the general manager may require.
  - (3) A provisional purchaser is authorized to
    - (a) purchase liquor in unopened containers that is sold under this section to the provisional purchaser, and
    - (b) sell or serve that liquor under the authority of the provisional purchaser’s licence without any further authorization under section 140.
  - (4) A provisional purchaser must not purchase liquor under this section through a delivery service within the meaning of section 194.

**Sales record to include licence number**

- 206.4** For the purposes of section 80 (2) (a) and (b), a provisional seller who sells liquor under section 206.3 must, for each sale,
- (a) create a record that includes the provisional purchaser's licence number and the information, if any, required under section 206.3 (2) (b), and
  - (b) give to the provisional purchaser a record that includes the provisional seller's licence number.

**Calculation of renewal fee**

- 206.5** (1) For the purposes of the renewal fee under section 204 and without limiting section 204 (1.1) (a), liquor purchases made under the authority of section 206.3 (3) by a provisional purchaser are not included.
- (2) For the purposes of the renewal fee under section 204 and without limiting section 204 (1.1) (b), liquor sales made under the authority of section 206.3 (1) by a licensee who holds a wine store licence are not included.
