

ORDER OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL

Order in Council No. 342

, Approved and Ordered June 9, 2023

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that,

- (a) effective September 1, 2023, the following provisions of the *Workers Compensation Amendment Act, 2022*, S.B.C. 2022, c. 3, are brought into force:
 - (i) sections 1, 3, 8, 10, 11 and 14 to 16;
 - (ii) section 9, except as it enacts sections 59.03 and 59.09 of the *Workers Compensation Act*, R.S.B.C. 2019, c. 1;
 - (iii) section 13, except as it enacts section 109 (2) (h.1) of the *Workers Compensation Act*, R.S.B.C. 2019, c. 1, and
- (b) effective January 1, 2024,
 - (i) the following provisions of the *Workers Compensation Amendment Act, 2022*, S.B.C. 2022, c. 3, are brought into force:
 - (A) section 9, as it enacts sections 59.03 and 59.09 of the *Workers Compensation Act*, R.S.B.C. 2019, c. 1;
 - (B) section 13, as it enacts section 109 (2) (h.1) of the *Workers Compensation Act*, R.S.B.C. 2019, c. 1, and
 - (ii) sections 4, 7 and 13 of the *Workers Compensation Amendment Act (No. 2), 2022*, S.B.C. 2022, c. 37, are brought into force.
