
Ministerial Order No. M236

I, Randene Neill, Minister of Water, Land and Resource Stewardship, order that, effective July 1, 2026,

- (a) the Closed Areas Regulation, B.C. Reg. 76/84, is amended as set out in Appendix 1,
- (b) the Designation and Exemption Regulation, B.C. Reg. 168/90, is amended as set out in Appendix 2,
- (c) the Hunting Regulation, B.C. Reg. 190/84, is amended as set out in Appendix 3,
- (d) the Limited Entry Hunting Regulation, B.C. Reg. 134/93, is amended as set out in Appendix 4,
- (e) the Motor Vehicle Prohibition Regulation, B.C. Reg. 18/2024, is amended as set out in Appendix 5,
- (f) the Wildlife Act Commercial Activities Regulation, B.C. Reg. 338/82, is amended as set out in Appendix 6,
and
- (g) the Wildlife Act General Regulation, B.C. Reg. 340/82, is amended as set out in Appendix 7.

APPENDIX 1

1 The following section is added to the Closed Areas Regulation, B.C. Reg. 76/84:

Conflict with other *Wildlife Act* regulations

- 1.1** If there is a conflict between this regulation and another regulation made under the Act, this regulation prevails to the extent of the conflict.

2 Schedule 3 is amended by adding the following sections:

Shaman Island

- 67** That portion of M.U. 6-25 that is outlined in red on the attached map 'Closed Area No. 3-67/26'.

Burnt River

- 68** That portion of M.U. 7-22 in the vicinity of Lower Burnt River Forest Service Road that is outlined in red on the attached map 'Closed Area No. 3-68/26'.

Nisga'a Highway

- 69** That portion of the Province of British Columbia within 400 metres of the road allowance of Highway 113 between Sterling Mountain Parking Lot Recreation Site and Kincolith (Gingolx) and east to Nass Camp that is highlighted in yellow on the attached map 'Closed Area No. 3-69/26'.

3 Schedule 5 is amended by repealing section 28 (7) (d).

4 Schedule 9 is amended in section 22

(a) by repealing paragraph (t) and substituting the following:

- (t) West Fraser Road from City of Quesnel city limits southerly to Grouse Road and those portions of M.U. 5-2 and M.U. 5-14 on the east side of the Fraser River in the vicinity of West Fraser Road all of which are highlighted in yellow on the attached map 'Closed Area No. 9-22t/26'; , ***and***

(b) by adding the following paragraph:

- (u) Highway 113 between Terrace and Sterling Mountain Parking Lot Recreation Site as shown highlighted in red on the attached map 'Closed Area 9-22u/26'.

APPENDIX 2

1 Section 10.1 (1) of the Designation and Exemption Regulation, B.C. Reg. 168/90, is amended by repealing paragraph (c) of the definition of “specified wildlife”.

2 The following section is added:

Exemption in relation to specified wildlife killed in M.U. 7-19

10.2 (1) In this section:

“specified highway” means any of the following:

- (a) Highway 16 between Hinton, Alberta and the British Columbia-Alberta border;
- (b) Highway 40 between Grande Prairie, Alberta and Hinton, Alberta;
- (c) Highway 43 between the British Columbia-Alberta border and Grande Prairie, Alberta;

“specified wildlife” means any of the following:

- (a) a mountain goat;
 - (b) a mountain sheep.
- (2) Subject to subsection (4), a person who hunts and kills specified wildlife in M.U. 7-19 is exempt from the following provisions with respect to that specified wildlife if the person has complied with all other provisions of the *Wildlife Act* and regulations respecting the person’s hunting, killing and possessing of that specified wildlife:
- (a) section 21 (1) (b) of the *Wildlife Act*;
 - (b) section 16 (1) (l), (2.1) (e) and (3) (b) of the Hunting Regulation, B.C. Reg. 190/84.
- (3) The exemption under subsection (2) applies only while transporting the wildlife
- (a) on a specified highway, or
 - (b) in a municipality or community along a specified highway.
- (4) The exemption under subsection (2) also applies to an agent of the person referred to in that subsection.

 - (i) in the case of males, either a testicle or a part of the penis, or
 - (ii) in the case of females, a portion of the teats or mammary gland, , ***and***

(e) by repealing subsection (4) (c) and substituting the following:

- (c) for a mountain sheep, the portion of the skull that includes, naturally attached to the skull, the nasal bones, eye socket, horns and the associated connective bone structure,

2 Section 16.1 (1) (h) is repealed.

(a) in subsection (1) by striking out “moose or caribou” and substituting “moose, caribou or elk” and by striking out “January 15” and substituting “March 31”, and

(b) in subsection (3) (c) (d) and (e) by striking out “moose or caribou” and substituting “moose, caribou or elk”.

 - (b) during the period of November 1 to April 15, use or operate a snowmobile weighing less than 500 kg.

- (a) a total length, based on the outside dimensions of the box, of at least 17 inches;
 - (b) a face plate hole with a diameter of no more than 2.25 inches;
 - (c) a side slot that is
 - (i) at least 10 inches long, and
 - (ii) no more than one inch high.
