



APPENDIX 1

1 Section 202 of the Liquor Control and Licensing Regulation, B.C. Reg. 241/2016, is amended by adding the following subsection:

- (3) Despite items 19 to 31 of Schedule 1, if an application is made to renew a licence or endorsement described in any of those items that expires before May 1, 2026, the fee that must be submitted under this section is the applicable fee under Schedule 1 as it read immediately before the coming into force of this subsection.

2 Schedule 1 is amended by striking out items 19 to 31 and substituting the following:

25	Brewery with manufacturer on-site store endorsement, special event area endorsement or lounge endorsement	fee in item 24 plus: for manufacturer on-site store endorsement or special event area endorsement: 143 for lounge endorsement: 429
26	Winery, if producing more than 135 000 litres of wine a year, with no endorsement	1 430
