COMMERCIAL LIENS REGULATION

Direction of seizure – prescribed information

- 1** For the purposes of section 32 (4) [*seizure by bailiff*] of the Act, the following information is prescribed to be included in a direction of seizure:
- (a) the name of the bailiff;
 - (b) the name of the lien holder;
 - (c) the name of the person who took possession of the goods from the lien holder;
 - (d) the date on which the lien holder signed the direction of seizure;
 - (e) the location of the goods, if known by the lien holder.

Bailee's undertaking – prescribed information

- 2** (1) In this section, “**base registration**” has the same meaning as in the Personal Property Security Regulation.
- (2) For the purposes of section 34 (1) (c) [*bailiff may appoint bailee*], the following information is prescribed to be included in the undertaking:
- (a) the name of the bailiff;
 - (b) the name of the person who is to be designated as the bailee;
 - (c) the date on which the person who is to be designated as the bailee signs the undertaking;
 - (d) a description of the goods to be held by the person who is to be designated as the bailee;
 - (e) the address of the location, or, if no address is available, a description of the location where the person who is to be designated as the bailee will hold the goods;
 - (f) the base registration number in relation to the lien.
