SCHEDULE 1

- 1** *Section 1 of the Medical Practitioners Regulation, B.C. Reg. 416/2008, is amended*
- (a) *by repealing the definition of “college”, and*
- (b) *by adding the following definition:*
- “registrant” means a registrant who is authorized under the bylaws to practise medicine; .

- 2** *The following section is added:*

College name

- 1.1** The name of the college responsible for carrying out the objects of the Act in respect of medicine is “College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia”.

SCHEDULE 2

- 1** *Section 1 of the Podiatrists Regulation, B.C. Reg. 214/2010, is amended by adding the following definition:*
- “registrant” means a registrant who is authorized under the bylaws to practise podiatric medicine.

- 2** *Section 2 is repealed and the following substituted:*

College name

- 2** The name of the college responsible for carrying out the objects of the Act in respect of podiatric medicine is “College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia”.
- 3** *Section 5 (2) is repealed and the following substituted:*
- (2) Only a registrant may provide a service that includes the performance of an activity set out in section 5 (1).
